Morgan County Tracked Its Best Year on Record in Tourism Spending

Tourism Industry Delivers \$60.3 Million in Economic Impact to Morgan County in 2022

MADISON, GA – October 9, 2023 – Visitors to Morgan County brought in \$60 million in total spending for calendar year 2022, surpassing pre-pandemic numbers (2019) of total visitor spending by \$10 million. According to The 2022 Economic Impact of Tourism in Georgia study, travel demand supported more than 550 jobs across Morgan County and visitors generated \$5.6 million in state and local taxes.

With a record high of \$768 saved per household in Morgan County in 2022, Main Street applauds the work the MMCVB has done and continues to do," said Sarah Wibell, Main Street Director for the City of Madison.

Madison Morgan County Convention & Visitors Bureau, Inc. (MMCVB), which serves as the official destination marketing organization for the City of Madison and Morgan County, helps drive visitor spending by inspiring tourists to come, stay and take part in the local tourism economy. Not only did visitor spending record a best-year-ever for tourism in Morgan County, but MMCVB's digital marketing efforts have also exceeded top performance numbers following the Launch of the new visitmadisonga.com website in 2021 that features mobile-first design, 10 times more content and a completely new look, feel and user experience. For the 2022 calendar year, VisitMadisonGA.com achieved over 20 percent growth in visitor sessions to the website when compared to calendar year 2019. And 2023 numbers are tracking even better, signaling what is sure to be another record-breaking year for tourism in Morgan County.

Tourism to Morgan County follows record-breaking numbers of visitors across the state, as total economic impact for Georgia travel and tourism reached \$73 billion in 2022 - a 13 percent year-over-year increase. Travel demand supported more than 442,600 jobs across the state, an increase of more than 20,000 jobs between 2021 and 2022.

According to Explore Georgia, The 2022 Economic Impact of Tourism in Georgia study, prepared by Tourism Economics, presents estimates of direct visitor spending and associated economic impacts at the state, region, and county levels in 2022. This comprehensive report offers credible measures of the aggregate statewide economic contributions of travel and tourism, including visitor expenditures (total and by industry sector), business sales (total economic impact), GDP impacts, employment and payroll income supported, tax revenues generated (for federal, state, and local governments), and more.




Visitor Spending by Category in 2022
